To Cast Your Ballot: Prior to the public hearing, completed ballots may be personally delivered to the City Clerk's Office located at 1400 Fifth Avenue, San Rafael, California; or mailed to the City Clerk of San Rafael at the address indicated below. A return envelope has been provided for your convenience that is addressed to the City Clerk. You may also personally present completed ballots to the City Clerk at the public hearing on June 20, 2011. If you return your ballot by mail, please be sure to allow time for mail delivery; the City Clerk must receive all ballots no later than the end of the public testimony portion of the public hearing on June 20, 2011. If you damage or misplace your ballot, a replacement ballot can be obtained from the City Clerk either by contacting the City Clerk's Office or by contacting Nader Mansourian, Public Works Director as indicated on the Notice accompanying this Ballot.


All submitted ballots must be clearly marked to indicate either "Yes — In Favor of Assessment" or "No — Opposed To Assessment" and signed; otherwise the ballot will be rejected and not counted. To ensure the privacy of your ballot prior to the tabulation, please return it in a sealed envelope and indicating that a ballot is enclosed by noting on the front of the envelope "Assessment Ballot -- Do Not Open". A ballot previously submitted may be withdrawn at any time prior to the close of the public hearing by request to the City Clerk by the person(s) that signed the submitted ballot. An assessment ballot may be changed at any time prior to the end of the public hearing by requesting a withdrawal of the previous ballot and requesting a replacement ballot. Only the person(s) signing the ballot may make such a request. The replacement ballot must be received by the City Clerk prior to the deadline set forth herein.
